

The municipality of Les Taillades has a population of about 2000 and is situated in the Department of Vaucluse, at the heart of the Luberon Regional Natural Park. It is part of the Luberon Monts de Vaucluse local authority.

It covers 675 hectares, including 320 hectares of forest. The neighbouring municipalities are Robion to the east (2.5 km), Cavaillon to the west (6 km) and Cheval Blanc to the south (6 km).

The village is well-sited geographically, 25 km from Avignon, 25 km from Apt and 15 km from L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue. A trunk road network provides good links to the main transport infrastructure (the A7 motorway) and major urban centres (Avignon at a distance of 30 km, Aix-en-Provence 56 km, Marseilles 80 km).

Whether you are passing through or simply curious – a stroller, walker or hiker – you will be charmed by the attractive features of the village: the waters of the Union Sorgue Ventoux canal flowing past St Peter's Mill and its impressive water-wheel, the stonework of the old village on a knoll facing the Luberon and the hiking trails with their wealth of colours and smells. (However, access is regulated during the summer because of the risk of fire. Be careful and be aware - ring 04 28 31 77 11 for information).
